Job Profile

This is a one year contract position, which may need to be extended further depending on how the project has progressed. The successful candidate must have a firm understanding of our culture as it pertains to servicing guests at a four diamond property. The candidate will also be well versed in safe and best work practices while fully respecting all of our H&S policies.

On the job training will be provided, but essentially the candidate will be engaged in a guest room project which consists of but is not limited to the following:

- Dismantling and disposal of drywall ceiling which will expose a fan coil unit
- Carefully dismantling the fan coil unit to expose a sealed drip pan, hot water coil, a chilled water coil and a squirrel cage fan assembly
- Thoroughly clean the two above mentioned coils as well as the squirrel cage. Then bench test the squirrel cage on all speeds to verify proper fan blade balance
- Carefully and exact reinstatement of the above items that will allow for proper ventilation and condensate drainage
- Meticulous test the fan coil through its entire range of heating / cooling and fan speeds to verify its proper operation
- Install new ceiling to cover over the fan coil unit. The ceiling would likely comprise of a steel stud and drywall system and may incorporate a T-Bar style ceiling depending on the guestroom type
- Finish the drywall joints seams, corner beads, etc., in preparation for paint
- Prime and paint all of the above
- Assist 3rd party contractors as required
- Lift and move heavy objects onto dollies
- Move bedroom furniture and fixtures to allow installation of new Fan Coils
- Clean up work area
- The candidate will also be required to participate in hotel training for emergency situations that may arise from the execution of this project
